

U.S. PARALYMPIC TEAM TRIALS 2016 RIO

Charlotte will host the 2016 U.S. Paralympic Team Trials, June 30–July 2. Set to be the largest Paralympic trials in U.S. history, the competition will host more than 400 athletes with Paralympic-eligible impairments who will compete for a chance to qualify for the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games as a member of Team USA on the cycling, swimming or track and field teams.

Following three days of competition, the event will culminate with a celebration on July 3rd, during which the U.S. team rosters for all three sports will be announced for the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games. The Rio Games are expected to be the largest Paralympic Games to-date; approximately 4,500 athletes from more than 165 countries will compete from September 7-18.
